Description:

This is a film festival where students, working in international groups, produce a film focusing in a central theme: Invisible Frontiers.

Objectives:

- Working in groups, students work through the pre-production process of film making to prepare to produce a short film.
- Working in groups, students work through the production process of filmmaking to prepare to produce a short film.
- Working in groups, students work through the post production process of filmmaking to finalize a short film.

Students show their final work in a juried exhibition.

Methods and Outcomes:

Student groups work independently but they can seek guidance from a variety of experts in the various aspects of filmmaking, including storytelling, casting, location scouting, filming, editing, and post-production audio.

The final outcome is a short film of up to 10 minutes which is shown at a juried exhibition on the last day of the week-long program.
